


Review - GMCN Conference April 2012

GLOBAL MEMBER CARE NETWORK CONFERENCE Global Voices on Global Challenges 23-27 April 2012, Chiang Mai, Thailand

"Great Connections! Great networking!" "So much is happening – I am encouraged!" "Fantastic" These were some of the responses to the first ever global Member Care consultation attended by 350 people.

The conference kicked off with a banquet and after-dinner speaker Harry Hoffman. Harry launched a new model of Member Care – the Pyramid of Care. This reflected the new reality that MC providers are increasingly being drawn and called into care of nationals, whether through crisis situations like tsunamis or earthquakes, or because of identification with the whole body of Christ. Members of the GMCN board were called upon to hold 8 ft bamboo poles (!!) to bear the 5 supports for Member Care – the church, the family and friends, the organisation, professions and centrally God. This really resonated with the conference a surfaced in many guises.



Of course Global diversity brings its challenges – worship styles, the use of time – making relationships or learning together?, styles of teaching and learning, and personal preferences – what suits me. The daily themes were spirituality, suffering, relationships and conflict. Many were encouraged to see Spirituality and Spiritual formation emerging as a key issue in building resilience in Mission workers and therefore in Member Care.

In many ways just being together was the highlight for many, experiencing and ministering the grace of God together. What could we have done better? More workshops? More time for shopping? Well... we need to take seriously the ability to follow dense presentations in English, to have readable powerpoints, to have workshops truly interactive and true to the brief, and interestingly to provide access to counselling for some who attend in need.

What next? The conference has certainly stimulated member care in Asia and a number of initiatives will come out of it. We identified the gaps in member care and the imbalance in resources. And EVERYONE wants another one! This will probably be in 2015 and we are looking at what will be the most strategic location.

We are grateful for all those who invested significantly of their time, money and self in making this conference possible. But most of all the breath of God which breathed life into a concept and desire and brought it to life and reality – to Him be the glory!
